

Veterinary requirements: EE-European Show Herning Denmark 9. – 11. November 2018

These are the official veterinary sanitary measures for animals entering Denmark as a result of their participation in the show.

Requirements given for the species listed in the Appendix A of the Washington Convention participating in the show apply.

EU-Border inspection and transit:

Permitted animals coming from third countries must have documentation of Border Inspection at the entry to EU and may not be sold.

Third country animals may entry only through Traveller's Entry Point: [Entry directly to Denmark](#) / [Entry to other EU Countries](#)

Exhibitors must consult countries of EU entry and transit for their veterinary requirements: [Member States websites](#)

Exhibitors must consult their country of origin for veterinary requirements for the return of animals from the exhibition

For all sections: All exhibited animals must be identifiable through the identifications scheme of the EE member countries. The rules of individual affiliated countries apply.

Animal suffering from disease or originating from areas under official restrictions due to disease outbreaks relevant to the species must not participate in the show.

Special requirements for sections

Poultry section: Fowls, ducks, geese, turkeys, guinea fowl, pheasants, quails and partridges.

Poultry coming from third countries may not participate in the show.

Poultry may not come from a herd where Newcastle (ND) or Avian Influenza (AI) has been present 30 days prior to the transport of the animal for the EE-European Show.

Poultry must be vaccinated against Newcastle disease (ND) at least 28 and not more than 90 days prior to the exhibition. The vaccination certificate must indicate the vaccination validity period.

The vaccine must have a marketing authorization for the concerned species, and the term of protection should be respected.

Pigeon section:

Pigeons coming from third countries may not participate in the show.

Pigeons may not come from a herd where Newcastle disease (ND) or Avian Influenza (AI) has been present 30 days prior of the transport of the animal to the EE-European Show. Pigeons must be vaccinated against Paramyxovirose at least 28 days and not more than 90 days prior to the exhibition. The vaccine must have a marketing authorization for the concerned species, and the term of protection should be respected.

Psittacine and passerine section: Parrots, sparrows and songbirds

Psittacine and passerine bird coming from Third countries (EE members Bosnia-Herzegovina, Serbia, Turkey and Russia (and FYROM) may only participate in the show when traveling as pet bird with their owner complying with [COMMISSION DECISION 2007/25/EC](#) (only 5 birds allowed)

I.e. they will only be able to enter EU and participate in the show

- if they have a valid certificate, drafted after the model in Annex II in Commission Decision 2007/25/EC as amended, stating compliance with Article 1 (b) i) or iii) or iv), and a complementary declaration of the owner or the representative of the owner in accordance with Annex III
- **AND have remained at least 30 days in a household or other residence of the owner after entry to the EU member state of destination, before participating in a show.**
(Note regarding Article 1 (b) ii): Denmark does not have quarantine facilities for birds)

Psittacine and passerine birds may not come from a herd where Newcastle Disease (ND), Avian Influenza (AI) or psittacosis has been present. For outbreak of ND and AI, the import ban is 30 days prior to transport of the birds to the show, and for Psittacosis the import ban is 60 days prior to transport of the birds to the show.
